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### **Introduction: NIME**

### 1978

Founded for R&D of *broadcasting programs* (+printed materials) for *Univ. of the Air (Japanese OU)* as a governmental institute

1997 Reorganized as a "*Governmental Institute for Interuniversity Collaboration*" for *educational use of ICT* in Higher Education

### 2004

Reorganized as an "*Independent Administrative Institution*" to realize government policies as the National Core Institution for the educational use of ICT in Higher Education

## Learning Objects: Our understanding

- 1) LOs are digital learning materials on the WWW.
- 2) LOs are sharable and reusable.
- 3) By preparing adequate and/or multiple levels of granularity, LOs can decrease their context-dependency.
- 4) Each LO has metadata
- 5) Small Business

### Summary

- GLOBE Phase 1: Simple federated search network (with matured technology and standards)
- GLOBE Phase 2: (with increasing number of member organizations), new architecture for new standardized federated repository and new technologies to realize next-generation value-added services, that is, copyright processing, quality assurance, localization and other user-support are necessary.
- Collaboration with international standardization bodies is indispensable.
- Collaboration with researcher community is also in Japan.
