## VII. Examination Schedule and Selection Method

## [Before]

(2) Selection Method

Selection is conducted by an oral examination. Applicants have a choice of speaking in English or Japanese. The total time of the examination is 30 minutes per applicant.

The examinations will be conducted with measures taken to avoid 3 Cs (Closed spaces, Crowded places and Close-contact setting).

① 7 minutes for presentation about the short essay submitted at the time of application.

A document projector is available. Please bring a set of printed materials (plain paper, A4 size) for a document projector to the examination venue. <u>The number of pages is unspecified</u>. Please do not staple them together. It is recommended to use horizontal sheets of paper. (i.e. long sides of a sheet come to the top and bottom.)

• Applicants can use notes during the presentation. However, they are strictly prohibited from distributing any materials and using any other electronic devices.

2 23 minutes for Q&A based on the short essay and the entry form submitted at the time of application.

## [After]

(2) Selection Method

Selection is conducted by an oral examination. Applicants have a choice of speaking in English or Japanese. The total time of the examination is 30 minutes per applicant.

The examinations will be conducted with measures taken to avoid 3 Cs (Closed spaces, Crowded places and Close-contact setting).

Therefore, the examiners will sit in a separate room from the examinees and the examination will be conducted using a video conferencing system.

① 7 minutes for presentation about the short essay submitted at the time of application.

Please bring one copy of printed materials in A4-sized paper on the day of your examination. <u>There is not page limit</u> <u>but please do not staple the materials</u>. They should be printed horizontally (i.e. the longest edge of paper comes to <u>the top and bottom of paper</u>.) Your printed materials will be digitalized by the staff at the reception. The digitalized data will be imported into a device (a laptop etc.) in the examinee's room and projected on a screen in the examiners' room. The examinee will give a presentation using the device (a laptop etc.) in the examinee's room.

• Applicants can use notes during the presentation. However, they are strictly prohibited from distributing any materials and using any other electronic devices.
