**【IMPORTANT】 About Outbreak of Novel Coronavirus (part 8)**

We strongly recommend you to get the latest information and continuously take prevention measures such as wearing a mask, washing your hands, etc.

Please do not go to a place where people gather not to spread infection.

**【Persons coming from China and Korea】**

From March 9 to the end of March (this period might be changed), all arrivals, Japanese or not, from China and Korea(including transit and arrivals by ship) will be quarantined for 14 days in the facility that government designated or medical institution based on the Quarantine Act. Also those people cannot use public transportations. If any students is considering to enter Japan during that period, please have extra time for your schedule.

In addition, there is news that arrivals who have a travel history of staying in north area of Italy might be refused entry, so please get up-to-date information.

Area raised to level 3

Italy:Lombardy region, Emilia-Romagna region, Veneto region, Piedmont region, Marche region, Republic of San Marino

Iran : Qom province, Tehran province and Gilan province, Alborz province, Isfahan province, Qazvin province, Golestan province, Semnan province, Mazandaran province, Markazi province, Lorestan province

Area raised to level 2

Korea: Areas except for Daegu city and North Gyeongsang province of Gyeongsan city, Yeongcheon city, Chilgok county, Andong city, Uiseong county, Seongju county, gunwi county, and Cheongdo county.

Italy: Areas except for listed above, Vatican City State

**【Persons coming from China and Korea】**

1. **【Travel to overseas (Infectious Disease Risk Information)】**

Risk Level 3 (Do not go to that area)

• (China)

Hubei province and Wenzhou city, Zhejiang province

• (South Korea)

Gyeongsan city, Yeongcheon city, Chilgok county, Andong city, Uiseong county, Seongju county, gunwi county, and Cheongdo county in North Gyeongsang province

• (Iran)

Qom province, Tehran province and Gilan province, Alborz province, Isfahan province, Qazvin province, Golestan province, Semnan province, Mazandaran province, Markazi province, Lorestan province,

• (Italy)

Lombardy region, Emilia-Romagna region, Veneto region, Piedmont region, Marche region, Republic of San Marino

Risk level 2 (Do not make a nonessential trip)

- (China) Areas other than above in China.
- (South Korea) Areas other than listed above
- (Iran) Areas other than listed above
- (Italy) Areas other than listed above
- Vatican City State

There are information that Indian government decided to invalidate pre-issue Visa for Japanese those who are not yet entered and suspend Japanese from entry and also, Thai government, Beijing city and Shanghai city are asking arrivals from Japan to stay at home and not to go out.

**【If you are suspicious of infection】**

3. All JAIST members regardless of arrival from overseas

(a). If you have cold symptoms, contact to [kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp](mailto:kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp) and follow the instruction. In this case, take your temperature and record it every day.

(b). Call the “the Consultation Center”

① If you meet following conditions, call the consultation center.

- Having cold symptoms, a fever of 37.5°C or over for 4 days or more (including when you need to continue to take an antipyretic (fever reducer)).
- Shortness of breath and strong fatigue (feel very tired) Consultation Center (Nomi city)

② If you are suspicious of a novel coronavirus infection after calling the center, go to a medical institution the center told you.

③ When you go to the medical institution, wear a mask, wash your hands, practice cough etiquette (when you cough or sneeze, cover your mouth and nose with a mask, tissue, handkerchief, or sleeve), and use a private vehicle (refrain from using public transportation).

④ Report the result to [kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp](mailto:kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp)

(c). Following persons may become severe when infected, so if you have condition of (b) for 2 days or more, please contact the consultation center.

- senior person (65 years old or older)
- person who has an underlying disease such as diabetes, heart failure, respiratory disease (DOPD), or taking a dialysis treatment.
- person who is taking immunosuppressant or anti-cancer drugs

(d). Pregnant woman become severe, so contact the consultation center early.

(e). For children, please take the same measure as (a).

#### 4. When a person staying in overseas

If you have a fever 37.5 or over, respiratory symptoms (cough, difficulty in breathing, sputum, etc.), please go to a medical institution on the spot, and report the result (medical certificate in original language or English is desirable) to [kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp](mailto:kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp)

#### 5. When arriving from overseas

(a). All members of JAIST need to inform following to [kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp](mailto:kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp)

Place to stayed, arrival date in Japan, health condition at the time of arrival (whether having fever, respiratory symptoms and taking medicine for a fever or cough).

(b). If you have a fever (37.5°C or over) or respiratory symptoms at the time of arrival in Japan, you must inform a quarantine officer about that and follow the instruction. Also contact [kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp](mailto:kikikanri@jaist.ac.jp)
