Our measures against the novel coronavirus infection(updated as of June 19)

In the email dated May 22 and 29, we informed you the measures we would practice as of those times.

In Ishikawa prefecture have not have any person confirmed with COVID-19 for 13 days (as of June 18).

In response to above, JAIST has decided to lift or continue some measures as follows.

With your cooperation, JAIST have not had any infected persons so far, however, please keep in mind that we are still facing the risk of getting infection.

We ask for your cooperation in preventing infection by strictly keeping the habits of wearing a mask, washing hands, practicing the cough etiquette, and avoiding "three Cs" (Closed spaces, Crowded places and Close-contact settings) because there are still risks of infection. In addition, we ask you to keep managing your health condition and avoiding nonessential and non-urgent outings and meetings.
